

Continuum Model Level I: Resource-Oriented Music & Imagery

A live international on-line training with Lisa Summer

Seminar: October 25-28, 2024 Practicum: January – May 2025

This training is comprised of four days of live on-line experiential training in a seminar style format, followed by a supervised five-month practicum with faculty from the Institute for Music & Consciousness

4 DAY SEMINAR

Through a combination of live teaching, discussion, and hands-on exercises, trainees will learn a step-by-step process that can be used to help facilitate a client's discovery of their inner resources through focused and intentional music listening. In this process:

- The therapist creates an empathetic therapeutic alliance and guides the client towards identification of supportive resource(s) as an entrance point for inner exploration
- Using a collaborative strategy, music is selected for a focused listening experience
- The client draws during the music to create a deepened, multi-sensory image of their resource
- The client learns to use the image and music as daily self-care

FIVE MONTH PRACTICUM: JANUARY – MAY 2025

The practicum is designed to help trainees understand and explore the practical application of the skills learned in the seminar. Trainees will conduct 12 Music and Imagery (MI) sessions with two well adult clients, 6 sessions per client, with supervision from IMC faculty: Sally McKnight Harrison, Carol Merle-Fishman, and Christine Routhier. Supervision includes personal music self-care assignments, guidance for client screening, videoconference supervision, and case analysis.

TUITION FEES: \$800 for the 4-day seminar + \$1,600 for practicum supervision = \$2,400 USD

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- For music therapists: graduate degree and entry level credential (i.e., MT-BC, MTA)
- For psychotherapists and other applicants: graduate degree and mental health professional credential
- All applicants should have a strong personal relationship with music
