Continuum Model Level II: Issue-oriented Music & Imagery

A live international on-line training with Lisa Summer Seminar Weekends: April 5-7 & May 4-5, 2024 Practicum: September 2024 – February 2025

This training is comprised of five days of live on-line experiential training in a seminar style format, followed by a supervised six-month practicum with faculty from the Institute for Music & Consciousness

5 DAY SEMINAR

Trainees will learn the Issue-oriented MI method through live teaching, discussion, and experiential exercises. The method is designed to help a client gain new perspectives about their current life issues through a step by step process:

- The therapist creates an empathetic therapeutic alliance and helps the client to confront engrained emotional issues as an entrance point for inner exploration
- Using a collaborative strategy, music is selected for a focused listening experience
- The client draws during the music to create a deepened, multi-sensory image of their issue
- The client learns to use the image and music to explore newly emerging perspectives in daily life

SIX MONTH PRACTICUM: SEPTEMBER 2024 - FEBRUARY 2025

The practicum is designed to help trainees understand and explore the practical application of the skills learned in the seminar. Trainees will conduct 16 Music and Imagery (MI) sessions with two well adult clients (8 sessions per client), with supervision from IMC faculty: Sally McKnight Harrison, Carol Merle-Fishman, and Christine Routhier. Supervision includes personal music self-care assignments, guidance for client screening, videoconference supervision, and case analysis.

TUITION FEES: \$1,000 for the 5-day seminar + \$1,600 for practicum supervision = \$2,600 USD
